To ensure forms arrive in time please make sure this is completed well in advance, it can take several days to organise and send exam report forms and longer in the postal system.

When completing the *Exam Request* form for multiple exam days please specify which grades will be held on which days or fill in separate forms for each day.

ASCA SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS 2015

Below are the requirements for the 2015 ASCA Scholarships, please take a moment to read through them. If you have any students who qualify send nominations to the Secretary, details are below.

The ASCA National Award for Excellence

*This scholarship award is worth \$800 and will usually be awarded annually to an outstanding student, nationally, who is working towards a Diploma exam.

*The student must be doing the Senior Grades from 6 upwards, including the *Certificate of Communication*.

*Outstanding marks must be achieved.

*Exam reports will need to be submitted for consideration.

*Written exams may be considered.

The Director's Award

*This award will usually be made annually to a candidate from each State (QLD, NSW, VIC.) for outstanding work leading up to and including a Diploma exam. The award is currently worth \$300.

*Students will need to submit exam reports from Senior Grade 6 upwards.

Nominations should reach the Secretary of ASCA, PO Box 4570 North Rocks NSW 2151 by the 31 December.
